5. The questions in this study guide that cover the books of the Bible are to help you understand the types of questions that will be asked. We may ask questions about books of the Bible that are not asked in the study guide. The questions will follow the format in the study guide.
6. The questions asked at Bible Quiz may not be worded exactly as found in this study guide. The content of the questions will be the same, but the wording may change slightly.
