<b>2 Timothy 2:15</b>	Study to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.
<b>Proverbs 30:5-6</b>	Every word of God is pure; He is a shield to those who put their trust in Him. Do not add to His words, Lest He rebuke you, and you be found a liar.

<b>Deuteronomy 18:22</b>	When a prophet speaks in the name of the LORD, if the thing does not happen or come to pass, that is the thing which the LORD has not spoken; the prophet has spoken it presumptuously; you shall not be afraid of him.
<b>Acts 16:29-31</b>	Then he called for a light, ran in, and fell down trembling before Paul and Silas. And he brought them out and said, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" So they said, "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household."
<b>Ephesians 2:8-9</b>	For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast.
<b>Exodus 20:3-4</b>	You shall have no other gods before Me. You shall not make for yourself a carved image—any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth;...
<b>Exodus 20:5a</b>	You shall not bow down to them nor serve them...
<b>Exodus 20:7a,8</b>	You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain. Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.
<b>Exodus 20:12-15</b>	Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be long upon the land which the Lord your God is giving you. You shall not murder. You shall not commit adultery. You shall not steal.
<b>Exodus 20:16-17</b>	You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor. You shall not covet your neighbor's house; you shall not covet your neighbor's wife, nor his male servant, nor his female servant, nor his ox, nor his donkey, nor anything that is your neighbor's.
<b>Titus 3:5</b>	Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit.
